CULINARY WALKING TOUR

This 3-hour guided culinary tour will take you to the best of the best on Amelia Island! Narration will start at the resort and carry you through to the downtown area, where the tour will continue on foot. Dr. Vikram Mansharamani applies a unique combination of practitioner experience and academic perspective to help audiences navigate the seemingly unending crosscurrents of global economic, financial and geopolitical uncertainty.

Today's dynamic global economy seems to be producing boom and bust cycles more frequently than in the past. There's always something that seems ahead of itself, having reached unsustainable levels. 
Breakout Sessions Designed for You
