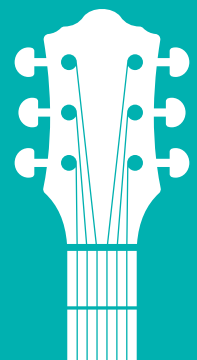

World Record Holder, Ironman Athlete, Author, Entrepreneur
